

SMALL BUSINESS ASSISTANCE NOW AVAILABLE IN HUDSON FOR FREE

Beginning Wednesday, August 10th, local entrepreneurs will have access to a powerful new resource designed to help them maximize their business potential. The Towns of Hudson, Keenesburg and Lochbuie, along with the Hudson and Keenesburg Area Chambers of Commerce and the I-76 Corridor Economic Development Initiative Steering Committee have partnered with the Northeast East Central Colorado Small Business Development Center (SBDC) to establish three new field offices along the I-76 Corridor. The SBDC field offices can be found in the following locations:

- Hudson – Hudson Public Library, 555 Main Street
- Keenesburg – Keenesburg Public Computing Center at Keenesburg Town Hall, 140 S. Main
- Lochbuie – Lochbuie Town Hall, 703 Weld County Road 37
