Ken Price, Edward Barrett, and John Monday with HR Green along with Nate Walowitz with NWCOG presented on the broadband report and how the Town can fund conduit throughout the Town.

3) GENERAL BUSINESS

- a. ORDINANCE 20-02: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 16, ARTICLE 4, OF THE HUDSON MUNICIPAL CODE TO CLARIFY SETBACK REQUIREMENTS FOR ACCESORY BUILDINGS IN THE R-1 AND R-2 ZONE DISTRICTS. SECOND READING**

Guy Patterson, Town Manager, reported that this is second reading of the ordinance that was presented on May 20, 2020.

Councilmember Warren made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Hammock to approve Ordinance No 20-02: an ordinance amending chapter 16, article 4, of the Hudson Municipal Code to clarify setback requirements for accessory buildings in the R-1 and R-2 zone districts. Second reading.

Maria Chavez, Councilmember, reported that she was wondering if there is any support for a GOCO grant submission.
