CITIZEN'S COMMENTS

Cody Peterson, Battalion Chief with the Hudson Fire Department, reported that the Battalion Chief's will be coming in to give the Town reports now. They are at 461 calls for the year in the Town limits of Hudson it has been 102 calls. They have spent \$4800 on COVID personal protection equipment.

Laura Hargis, Mayor, called up each applicant for the Town Council vacancy and introduced all applicants to council.

Councilmember Hammock made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Stadler to appoint Jeffery Houck to the Town Council Vacancy.

b. 205 ELM STREET FIRE PROCLAMATION

Laura Hargis, Mayor, presented a proclamation to Memo Uribies for his heroic actions during the fire on his home located at 205 Elm Street in Hudson.

3) STAFF REPORTS

Guy Patterson, Town Manager, brought up the discussion of having Town Hall open four days a week with longer hours for residents to have accessibility to Town Hall around the 8 to 5 workday. He also reported that he gave council a budget calendar. He also reported that CDOT contacted him about changing the exit ramp off I-76.

Jay Hirokawa, Police Chief, reported that he just certified the Hudson and Lochbuie police departments on their use of force practices. He also reported that with the new law enforcement laws he has been making a lot of policy changes.

Hunter Fobare, Public Works and Utilities Director, reported that his crew had to take care of a couple of water leaks and they have been fighting some alkaline soil on the new soccer field.

Charity Campfield, Town Clerk, reported that the management letter for the audit should be done soon.

Laura Hargis, Mayor, reported that she wants to get away from FRII for the webmail. She also reported that the pandemic relief for the water late charges has expired. She asked council where they stand on extending it.

Councilmember Stadler made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Warren to extend the relief on water delinquent charges to July 31st.

The vote was as follows:

Mayor Hargis declared the motion carried.

4) CITIZEN'S COMMENTS
