

TO PROVIDE FOR SUBMITTING THE QUESTION OF CONSTRUCTION AND ERECTION OF A SYSTEM OF WATERWORKS AND APPURTENANCES THERETO, AND FOR ACQUIRING WATER SUPPLY TO THOSE VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON WHO ARE TAX PAYERS UNDER THE LAW, VOTING ON THE QUESTION AT A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON THE 18th DAY OF AUGUST 1914.

WHEREAS, the Town of Hudson now has an inadequate water supply for domestic purposes and a new system of waterworks is, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees of said town, necessary; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications approved by the Board of Trustees of said town have been made and are now on file in the office of the Town Clerk and the same are estimated to involve the expenditures of \$12,000;

Be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson, Weld County, Colorado:

SECTION I. That a special election be held in said Town of Hudson on Tuesday, the 18 day of August, 1914 at which there be submitted to such of the qualified electors of said Town who are tax payers under the law, voting at said election the question of the erection and construction of a waterworks system for the purpose of supplying to said Town and its inhabitants sufficient water to furnish an adequate supply and to provide for the payment of said erection and construction of waterworks and the acquisition of water supply by an issue and sale of bonds of said town to be hereafter issued pursuant to Ordinance in that behalf to be passed by the Board of Trustees of said town in form and in terms as by law required; provided the aggregate principle of said bonds shall not exceed TWELVE THOUSAND DOLLARS, (\$12,000.00).

SECTION II. At such special election ballot boxes shall be furnished to the judges of election in which shall be deposited all ballots cast for or against the question so submitted, which ballots shall be received, counted, certified, returned and canvassed by the election judges and other election officers as by law provided. Ballots shall be furnished at the polling place with words "FOR CONSTRUCTION OF WATERWORKS", or "AGAINST CONSTRUCTION OF WATERWORKS". Only such qualified voters is said town who are tax payers under the law shall be permitted to vote upon said question so submitted. Due notice

of the submission of said question shall be given by incorporating a copy of this Ordinance and a notice of said election to be signed by the Mayor and the Town Clerk of said Town and published in some newspaper published in said Town at least FIFTEEN DAYS (15 days) prior to the holding of said election and by posting a printed copy of said notice in the polling place.

SECTION III. The polls of said election shall be opened at SEVEN (7) A. M. AND CLOSED AT EIGHT(8) P. M. The polling place for said election shall be HELD IN THE D. R. I. OFFICE.

SECTION IV. If at such election a majority of the votes cast shall be in favor of the construction of said waterworks the Board of Trustees shall proceed to take any and all steps necessary and proper to construct such waterworks and acquire such water supply for the Town of Hudson and its inhabitants for domestic, fire, sprinkling lawns and parks and other principle municipal purposes as it deems necessary and shall by Ordinance provide for the issuance and sale of such bonds as may be necessary and proper for said purposes.
