

ORDINANCE NO 16

An Ordinance Concerning Offenses: Driving Autos, Riding and driving on Sidewalks, and permitting live stock to run at large.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, STATE OF COLORADO.

ARTICLE ONE

SECTION 1. Any persons who shall be drunk or shall be in a state of intoxication in any public place within this town, or shall be drunk and disorderly in any house or place, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in a sum not less than five dollars, not more than Fifty dollars and the Town Marshal and all Police officers of this town are hereby authorized and empowered, and it is hereby made their duty, to arrest, with or without process, any person found violating any provision of this section, and commit such person to the town jail or other safe place until sober, at which time or as soon thereafter as may be, such person shall be brought before the Police Magistrate to be dealt with according to law.

SECTION 2. Any person who shall, within this town, cause, engage in, instigate or encourage any riot, bout, affray or fight; and any person who shall disturb others by loud and unusual noises, or by violent, offensive conduct or cassage, or by insulting profane, obscene or offensive language calculate to provoke a breach of the peace; and any persons who shall disturb any congregation or assembly set for religious worship by making a noise, or by rude or indecent behavior, or by profane or indecent language within their place of worship, or so near the place as to disturb the order and solatary of the meeting; or shall in a like manner disturb or interfere with any lawful assemble of people thereof, shall be fined not exceeding Fifty dollars and costs.

SECTION 3. Any person who shall lead, ride or drive any horse or other animal, or shall ride any bicycle or drive any automobile or other conveyance along or upon any sidewalk in this town, or walk along the side of any street commonly used by pedestrians as a sidewalk, whether paved or not, or upon any walk within the town park, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in a sum not less than five dollars not more than Twenty five dollars and costs.

SECTION 4. No person or corporation shall, without the written permission of the Board of Trustees first get and obtain, make any excavation of any kind or character in any street or alley or public place, or remove from, or deposit upon, any street or alley, any dirt, earth, or rock, or store or pile in any such place any hay, straw, manure, boxes, barrels, building material.

All excavations herein specified shall be safely guarded by a suitable rail or fence, and if left open at night - shall further provided with red lights in order that persons and animals shall not fall therein or be injured thereby. Any person violating any of the provisions of this section upon conviction therefore shall be fined in a sum no exceeding fifty dollars and costs.

ARTICLE TWO

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride or drive any automobile or other self-propelled vehicle, motorcycle within the limits of the Town of Hudson at a rate of speed greater than twelve miles per hour.

SECTION 2. No person shall ride or drive any automobile, motorcycle, or other self-propelled vehicle within the limits of the town of Hudson, thirty minutes after sunset with displaying on the front of the automobile at least one lamp, well lighted.

SECTION 3. Upon conviction of a violation of any of the provisions of this article, the person or persons so convicted, shall be fined not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars and costs.

ARTICLE THREE

SECTION 1. No horses, asses, mules, cattle, sheep, goats, swine, or geese shall be permitted to run at large within the town of Hudson nor shall any such animal or animals be so picketed upon any lot or private grounds so as to unable such animal or animals to trespass upon any street sidewalk, alley or public grounds of the Town, and any person or persons owning or having right of possession to any such animal as herein prohibited, shall for each offense upon conviction thereof be fined not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars and costs of suit.


SECTION 2. The Town Marshal, for taking up and impounding any animal or animals, named in the foregoing section, found running at large as by this ordinance prohibited, shall be entitled to confiscation as follows; for every horse, ass, mule, bull, cow or calf, 50 cents for impounding and 50 cents additional for every day such animal shall be kept. For every other animal owned herein 75 cents for impounding and 25 cents additional for every day kept by him. For selling each animal herein warned as hereinafter provided, the sum of seventy five cents.

SECTION 3. The Town Marshal upon taking up and impounding of any such animals shall give notice as provided by the provisions of section 6437 Revised Statute of Colorado 1908 to which reference is hereby made, and made a part hereof by reference thereto.
