TITLE: A RESOLUTION APPROVING A WATER AND WASTERWATER ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR FEDERAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, COLORADO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to its authority to establish utility rates and fees by resolution, as set forth in Chapter 13, Article 2, of the Hudson Municipal Code, the Town Council hereby approves the **Water and Wastewater Assistance Program for Federal Government Employees** substantially in the form outlined in the program guide attached hereto.

Section 2. For approved applicants with Town water or wastewater bills that come due during a federal government shutdown in duration of two (2) weeks or more, the Town may temporarily suspend collection of water and wastewater charges without interest or penalty. All amounts due shall be paid within six (6) months of the re-opening of the federal government.

Section 3. Suspended water and wastewater charges that remain unpaid after six (6) months of the re-opening of the federal government will be assessed late fees pursuant to Section 13-24 of the Hudson Municipal Code, at which time all other provisions regarding discontinuance and resumption of service and all other remedies for nonpayment shall apply.

Section 4. For the most recent federal government shutdown, which began on December 21, 2018, and ended on January 25, 2019, this program may apply to approved applicants, and all amounts due shall be paid by July 25, 2019.

Water and Wastewater Assistance Program for Federal Government Employees

Program Guide

By Resolution No. 19- 06, the Town authorized the temporary suspension of water and wastewater charges for approved applicants who are federal employees affected by a federal government shutdown in duration of two (2) weeks or more. All suspended amounts must be paid within six (6) months of the re-opening of the federal government or late fees and other penalties will apply.

For the most recent shutdown, from December 21, 2018, through January 25, 2019, all suspended amounts due must be paid by July 25, 2019.

To apply, please bring or mail copies of the following information to Town Hall:

- A Town utility bill showing a residential water or wastewater account in your name, your spouse's name, or your landlord's name.
- Proof by deed or lease that you occupy the residence associated with the utility account.
- Documents showing you are a U.S. citizen, legal permanent resident or otherwise lawfully present in the U.S. pursuant to federal law
 - o A Colorado Driver's License or ID card, U.S. Passport, or Permanent Resident Card
 - o Other forms of proof as outlined by the Colorado Department of Revenue on Form DR 2300A
- Proof you are a federal government employee:
 - o Notification of Personnel Action (SF50) or a December 2018 payroll check stub

A new application must be submitted and approved for each separate shutdown.
