Town of Hudson Safer at Home Policies

In accordance with the Governor's Safer at Home policies, the Town of Hudson will adopt the following policies beginning Monday, May 4, 2020. These policies will stay in place until further notice.

Town Hall

- Town hall will reopen to the public on May 4, 2020. Hours will be 8am to 5pm.
- Anyone visiting the town hall will be required to wear a cloth facemask or some other form of face covering.
- Only one party at a time will be allowed in Town Hall. A party can only be three or less people who are working on a related issue or are family.
- Individuals will be asked to NOT enter Town Hall if they have any symptoms, have had contact with a person who has tested positive for coronavirus, etc.
- Citizens will still be encouraged to use online bill paying and communicate with staff via phone and email.
- Social distancing will be practiced.
- Town hall staff will stagger to come in every other day to keep the internal staff levels below 60%.
- Meetings with Town Staff (planning issues, etc) will still be conducted via conference call. Face-to-face meetings for items other than front desk issues with Town staff will not be allowed.
- Town Hall staff will be required to take self-evaluation steps every day before coming to work (temperature, declaring no contact with infected, etc)

Police/Public Works

- Both Police and Public Works will continue to adhere to their modified schedules.

- The Ash Street sidewalk project will continue as planned.

Public Areas/Events

- Town playgrounds will also reopen on May 4, 2020. In accord with state policy, no gatherings of more than 10 people will be permitted. If compliance with that limit becomes an issue, the town may again close the playgrounds and parks. The Town asks citizens and guests to respect social distancing guidelines. Please note, Town staff does NOT sanitize playground equipment. Please use caution.
- Town Clean-Up Days are still scheduled for May 15th and 16th. Due to social distancing guidelines, town staff will not be available to assist residents in dumping their materials.
- Most other Town events have been postponed or cancelled. Please refer to the Town website (www.hudsoncolorado.org) for scheduling information.

Town Meetings

- The Town Council will continue holding remote council meetings (via Zoom) in May 2020, with hopes to resume in-person, regular council meetings at town hall beginning with the June 3, 2020 meeting. Even when in-person meetings resume, council members and town staff will wear face-coverings and follow appropriate social distancing protocols.
- When in-person meetings resume, the council will strongly encourage any public participation via livestreaming for the next several months. If you have an urgent need to address the council, you are always free to email the town clerk, Charity Campfield, in advance of the meeting, and she will pass a copy of your email on to the council. If you feel that your in-person attendance is absolutely necessary, we politely request that you advise the town clerk in advance of the meeting of your desire to attend.
