

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A PUBLIC LIBRARY AND READING ROOM FOR THE TOWN OF HUDSON, AND PROVIDING FOR ITS MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION.

Section I. There is hereby created and established a free public library in and for the Town of Hudson.

Section II. Said library shall be under the control of a board of seven directors, consisting of the mayor of said town and six citizens of said town, who during their term of office shall not be members of the Board of Directors of said town.

Section III. The Mayor of the Town of Hudson shall, with the approval of the Board of Trustees, proceed to appoint six persons from the citizens at large of said town who, with the mayor, shall constitute the Board of Directors, and the President of said board shall be the mayor of the Town of Hudson.

Section IV. Such Board of Directors shall constitute a body corporate by the name and style of "The Board of Directors of the Public Library of the Town of Hudson, Colorado."

Section V. Said Board shall have the power to employ such officers and employees as they shall deem necessary, and exercise all powers provided by the laws of the State of Colorado, or such powers as may hereafter be provided.

Section VI. Beginning with the tax levy for 1952, a levy not exceeding one mill shall be levied annually for the support and maintenance of aforesaid public library and reading room.

Section VII. Any person who shall fail to return any book belonging to the library within ten days after request by the librarian or library board, or who shall injure or destroy any book, property or building of said corporation shall, on

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conviction, be fined in a sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars.
