

ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 48 OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO, PASSED, ADOPTED AND APPROVED THE FOURTH DAY OF AUGUST, A. D. 1952.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF HUDSON, WELD COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. That, whereas by Ordinance No. 48, duly passed and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson, Weld County, Colorado, on August 4, 1952, the Pike's Peak Natural Gas Company, a Colorado Corporation, was granted the right and authority to construct, install, maintain and operate a gas transmission and distribution system, including mains, pipes, conduits, structures and appliances appertaining in, under, upon, over, across and along the streets, alleys, bridges and public places within the present and future corporate limits of the Town of Hudson, Colorado, for the furnishing, transmission, distribution and sale of gas, whether artificial, natural, mixed or otherwise, for heating, domestic, industrial and other purposes, and for transmitting gas to, through and beyond said Town, and

Whereas Section 7 of said ordinance provides that after not less than eighteen months from the effective date of said ordinance, the Town of Hudson may, by ordinance, cancel and terminate said franchise, provided that said Town give the Pike's Peak Natural Gas Company ninety (90) days prior written notice of intention to cancel and terminate said franchise, and,

Whereas, by resolution duly passed and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson, Weld County, Colorado, at a regular meeting of said Board of Trustees duly convened on March 7, 1955, the Town Clerk of the Town of Hudson was authorized, empowered and instructed to prepare and send to the Pike's Peak Natural Gas Company notice of intention to cancel and terminate the franchise granted to the Pike's Peak Natural Gas Company by said Ordinance No. 48, by registered mail with return receipt requested, and that the Town Clerk file said receipt with the minutes of said meeting, and

Whereas the Town Clerk, pursuant to said resolution, did prepare and send to the Pike's Peak Natural Gas Company written notice of the intent of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson, Weld County, Colorado, to cancel and terminate by ordinance the franchise granted to the Pike's Peak Natural Gas Company under Ordinance No. 48 of the Town of Hudson after ninety (90) days from the date of said notice; and

Whereas said Notice was dated the 10th day of March, A. D. 1955, and was sent to the Pike's Peak Natural Gas Company on the 10th day of March, A. D. 1955, by registered mail with return receipt requested, and whereas the said return receipt has been filed with the minutes of the regular meeting duly convened on March 7, 1955, and

Whereas more than ninety (90) days have elapsed since written notice of intention to cancel and terminate said franchise was given to the Pike's Peak Natural Gas Company.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 48 of the Town of Hudson, Weld County, Colorado, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson, Weld County, Colorado, an emergency exists and this Ordinance is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and property;

Therefore, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and be published as required by law.
