

ORDINANCE NO. 114

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 107 ADOPTED DECEMBER 10, 1975, AND CONCERNING THE ENACTMENT OF WATER RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE TOWN OF HUDSON, SETTING WATER RATES AND TAP FEES AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson, Colorado, have by Ordinance No. 107, passed and adopted December 10, 1975, enacted an Ordinance providing for the enactment of water rules and regulations for the Town of Hudson setting water rates and tap fees and providing for penalties for violations, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson, Colorado, wish to increase the tap fee for a water tap from \$500.00 to \$1,500.00 for each connection to the Town's water system;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson, Colorado:

Section 1. Section 6. of Ordinance No. 107 passed and adopted December 10, 1975, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. Tapping Charge Upon the application for a new tap and service connection by any consumer, within the corporate limits of the Town, the applicant shall pay to the Town Clerk the sum of \$1,500.00 for each connection to the Town's water system. Each dwelling unit in a multiple dwelling unit structure shall be considered a separate tap.

There shall be no requirement for the Town to furnish any water tap larger than 3/4 inch in diameter.

The consumer shall also pay prior to turning on of water service to the Town Clerk for each new water tap a fee which shall be the total sum of the following charges: the actual cost to the Town of the corporation cock, copper pipe, expansion joint, curb box, tapping saddle, and where applicable, a water meter. The meter shall be furnished, but not purchased, by the Town, to make such tap. All necessary trenching and backfilling shall be at the expense of the applicant and under supervision of the Town Super-

intendent. The Town shall own and maintain the water line from the main to the curb box and the property owner shall own and maintain the service line from the curb box to the premises served. All work upon the service line shall be performed by a licensed plumber or to Town specification and inspection."

Section 2. No other provisions or sections of Ordinance No. 107 passed and adopted December 10, 1975, are affected hereby, and only Section 6. of said Ordinance No. 107 is amended to provide for a tap fee of \$1,500.00. All other provisions and sections of said Ordinance No. 107 shall remain in full force and effect.


Section 3. In the opinion of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Hudson, Colorado, this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate protection and preservation of the public health, safety, convenience and general welfare, and it is passed and adopted for that purpose.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after its final publication.
